## \$975,000 settlement in Chicago porch fall that killed Lombard man

The mother of a 24-year-old man who died as the result of porch fall on Chicago's North Side more than four years ago has been awarded \$975,000 in settlement of a wrongful death suit, her attorney said Tuesday.

Sean Heflin, then 24, fell from a second-floor porch railing at his girlfriend's apartment in the 1900 block of North Bissell Street in July 2007, attorney Steven Levin said. The Lombard man, who suffered a brain injury, died a little more than six months later.
