

Lake Zurich nursing home sued for negligence

A lawsuit has been filed in the Cook County Circuit Court accusing a Lake Zurich nursing home of negligence.

According to the Lake County News-Sun, the suit was filed on behalf of Edna Kneidek, a resident of the Lexington Health Care Center of Lake Zurich who suffered a hip fracture at the home in 2007 that left her permanently disabled.

Attorney Steve Levin of Chicago told the newspaper that when Kneidek entered the home in December 2006, she was assessed as being at-risk for falls. Levin said his client fell five times from February through August in 2007, one fall resulting in the injury to her left hip.
